Beans: Dragon Langerie	August - Frost	Lime green w/ purple stripes, heirloom romano
Beans: Fava	Mid July-early Aug	Windsor heirloom
Beans: Green Beans	August - Frost	Green. Beans.
Beans: Mixed Beans	August - Frost	green, dragon langerie, yellow wax, purple mix
Beans: Yellow Wax	August - Frost	Beurre de Rocquencourt, French heirloom.
Beets: Bulk Beets	Late July - January	No tops, Golden & Red Ace. 2+" dia.
Beets: Mixed Baby	Mid July - October	1 " dia, Golden & Red Ace with tops, trimmed
Beets: Mixed Medium Beets	Mid July - October	1.5-2" dia, Golden & Red Ace with tops, trimmed
Broccoli	July-October	Full heads, trimmed.
Brussels Sprouts	October-Nov	By the stalk, 25-30 ct sprouts/stalk. Frost sweetened.
Cabbage: Red	Sept-Dec	2-5 # red heads
Cabbage: Caraflex	Late June -	~1# pointy headed green cabbage, fine leaf.
Cabbage: Green	September - Dec.	2-5# Green or Red heads in the fall.
Cabbage: Napa	July - October	Chinese cabbage
Cabbage: Savoy	September - Dec.	Green savoyed heads. 2-3#
Carrots: Bunched	Mid July - October	12 oz bunches w/tops of slender orange carrots, Napoli, Nectar...
Carrots: Baby Carrots	July - December	Orange only, finger size, 1.5" trimmed tops
Carrots: Large Carrots	Late July - Dec	7-10" bulk orange carrots.
Cauliflower, Purple	August - Sept	Purple Graffiti Heads
Cauliflower, White	August - Oct	White Skywalker Heads
Celeriac	October - Dec	Smooth white flesh 4-5" dia.
Chard: Green	Late June - Oct	Green stem, white leaf.
Chard: Rainbow	Late June - Oct	Yellow, white, red, orange stems, green & red leaves
Chard: Red Rhubarb	Late June - Oct	Red stems, red/green leaves
Collard Greens: Bunched	June - November	Full Size "Top Bunch" Collards, bunched
Cucumber, Asian	Late June - Late	Tasty Jade and Telegraph Improved, 12" x 1.5" - 2"
Cucumber, Slicing	July - Frost	7-8" American Slicers. "Corinto"
Edible Flowers	Late May - Mid Oct	50 ct basket Marigold, viola, or borage; 25 ct nasturtium
Eggplant	August/Sept	Orient express, Slender and Tender light and dark Purple Asian type.
Fennel Bulb	*July -Sept	~ 8 oz each, trimmed
Garlic	Aug - Feb	4 hardneck & 1 softneck varieties.
Garlic: Garlic Scape	Lt.June/Early July	Unopened flower bud of hardneck garlic!
Garlic: Green Garlic	Mid June	Mid June only, scallion-like immature garlic.
Greens: Arugula	Late May - October	Salad Arugula, Astro Strap leaf and Esmee Oak leaf.
Greens: Asian Mix	May-Sept	Baby green wave, Osaka Purple, Ruby Streaks, Golden Frills...mix
Greens: Bok Choi	*May - October	8-12" tall mature plants, crisp white stems
Greens: Bok Choi Baby	*May - October	4-6" tall
Greens: Braising Greens	June - October	Hand sized mixed leaf cooking greens: Kale, chard, mustard, beet,...
Greens: Broccoli Raab	*June - October	Green sprouting Broccoli, Asian and/or Italian types
Greens: Frisee	Oct	Tres fine maraichere heads
Greens: Lettuce Mix	Late May - Mid Oct	10-15 varieties, colourful mix with loft and texture, 2-3" tall
Greens: Kale, Baby	Late May - Mid Oct	Baby lacinato and/or red russian mix
Greens: Mustard	Late June-Sept	Large Mustard greens, quite spicy.
Greens: Radicchio	Oct.	Round Red Heads, 1# or so.
Greens: Spinach, Baby	Late May -	Salad quality spinach leaves
Greens: Spinach, Braising	June - November	Thick cooking spinach, Space in fall/winter/spring, tyee in summer
Herbs: Basil, Genovese	June - September	Italian heirloom, Pesto at its best! Tender Tips only!
Herbs: Chervil	*June - Sept	Lacy delicate anise greens.
Herbs: Chives	Late May - October	Flowers in the early spring, fine green leaf afterwards.
Herbs: Cilantro	June - October	Santo bunched cilantro.
Herbs: Dill, Fernleaf	June - Sept	Best dill for greens. Blue green foliage. No stems.
Herbs: Sorrel	Late May - Sept	Garden sorrel, elongated tart lemon leaves
Herbs: Lovage	Late May - Sept	Intense flavor, celery like leaves
Herbs: Mint, Bunched	Late May-Sept	Chocolate, peppermint, cuban, apple mint, spearmint mix. Bunched!
Herbs: Mint, Mixed Tips	Late May-Sept	Chocolate, peppermint, cuban, apple mint, spearmint mix. Tips only!

Herbs: Parsley	Late June - Oct	Flatleaf Italian
Herbs: Sage	June - October	Garden Sage, Long sage green leaves
Herbs: Thyme	Late June-Sept	German thyme
Jerusalem Artichoke	Late Sept - January	Knobby roots, Native American Heirloom
Kale: Green	Late June - Oct	Nash's Green, pretty frilly green leaf, green stem.
Kale: Lacinato	Late June - Oct	Dinosaur or Black Kale, medium to large leaf
Kale: Red	Late June - Oct	Rioja, red leaf, red stem.
Kohlrabi	*June - November	Kohlibri, Purple skin, tender white flesh
Lettuce Heads: Baby GrRomaine	June - October	Very small dense green romaine
Lettuce Heads: Gr. Butterhead/	June - October	Green Butter heads
Lettuce Heads: Green Leaf	June - October	Full heads, dense green full size heads.
Lettuce Heads: Green Oak Leaf	June, early July	Full heads, uniform bright green oak leaves.
Lettuce Heads: Red Leaf	June - October	Full dense red heads
Lettuce Heads: Green Romaine	June - October	Green romaine always available.
Lettuce Heads: Summer Crisp	August/Sept	Upright red crisp summer heads
Microgreens: Brassica Mix	Year round	Blend of 7-8 different brassicas, moderately spicy, reds, greens...
Microgreens: Cilantro	Year round	Pretty cilantro micros w/ 1 true leaf. LTD, Standing orders!
Microgreens: Pea Shoots	Year round	Sweet pea shoots. Ltd. Production.
Microgreens: Sun Shoots	Year round	Sunflower shoots, Ltd. Production,
Onions: Cipollini Onions	September - Dec.	Borretana, yellow It Heirloom & Red Marble. Flat Italian specialty.
Onions: Leeks	August - Nov	Large Summer & winter leeks. 8-10 oz each, trimmed.
Onions: Red	Aug - Dec	Red round storage onions
Onions: Red Long of Tropea	July - September	Long Red Italian Summer Onions!
Onions: Scallions	June - October	White scallions, 7-8 bunches/#. Aka Green Onions.
Onions: Shallots	Aug - Feb	Saffron, yellow and Prisma, red shallots from seed.
Onions: Yellow Onions	Aug - Dec	Walla Walla, then Candy. Yellow onions
Parsnips	October - Dec	Frost sweetened. Large to med. Long White roots.
Peas: English	Late June - July	Peas in the pod!
Peas: Snap	Late June - July	Sugar snap peas edible pod
Peas: Snow	Late June - July	Mammoth Melting edible pod snow peas.
Peppers: Ancho	August - Mid Sept	Dark Green mildly spicy peppers
Peppers: Carmen	August - Mid Sept	Green to Red sweet, thick wall Corno di Toro type. 2" x 8"
Peppers: Jalapeno	August - Mid Sept	Medium spice
Peppers: Shishito	August - Mid Sept	Wrinkly green Japanese Frying Peppers
Pie Pumpkin	September - Dec.	Baby Pam, Then Long Pie Pumpkin
Potatoes: New	August	Dark Red Norlands, then Yukon Nugget
Potatoes: Standard	Sept - late Winter	Rio Grande Russet, German Butterball, and Huckleberry Gold

Summer Squash: Squash blossoms	July - September	12 ct blossoms.
Summer Squash: Baby	July - September	Yellow, green babies 2-3" dia
Summer Squash: Pattypan	July - September	3-4" dia yellow
Summer Squash: Zucchini	July - September	6-8" dark green, Zephyr (yellow w/ green tip) or Yellow
Tomatoes: Cherry tomatoes	July - October	Per pint, Sungold, Black Cherry, Sun Peach, Galinas, Super Sweet 100
Tomatoes: Green Tomatoes	July - Oct	*Green slicers
Tomatoes: Heirlooms	August - Oct	Striped German, Pruden's, Black Krim,...
Tomatoes: Roma	August - October	Field Grown Romas,
Turnips: Hakurei	Mid June - Oct	White, smooth, and sweet salad turnips with tops.
Rutabaga	October - Dec.	Laurentian Rutabagas, rough looking sweet tubers
Winter Squash: Acorn	Sept - Winter	Sweet Reba, Tuffy, 1-1.5# each.
Winter Squash: Buttercup	Sept - Winter	Bon bon and Dakota Dessert Buttercup, 2-4# each
Winter Squash: Delicata	Sept - Winter	White w/green stripes; 1.5# Pale orange flesh.
Winter Squash: Eastern Rise	Sept - Winter	Orange Kabocha/Buttercup hybrid. 2-3# each, excellent
Winter Squash: Spaghetti	Sept - Winter	Pale yellow skin and stringy tender flesh. 3-5# spaghetti squash
